The contributions of small-scale fisheries to poverty alleviation and food and nutrition security are being increasingly recognized and Voluntary Guidelines for Securing Sustainable Small-scale Fisheries has been developed by FAO. The coastal fisheries in Japan, which is multispecies resources and multi-gear fisheries dominated by smaller vessels, shares similarities with those of developing countries and the experiences of the Japanese fisheries development can be applied to design the action plan for the participants' countries.
