Term of Reference Program Officer (PO)

PO shall work as part of a team to implement ODA (Official Development Assistance) projects and information gathering/analysis on the following scope:

Job Description:

- Process, Implement, and Administer Technical Assistance, Loans, and Grant Projects of economic and social development in Indonesia, in close collaboration with the related Japanese officers.
- Engage in portfolio management and regular communication with the relevant executing agencies and coordinating institutions of the Government of Indonesia (GOI).
- Promote network and regular communication with stakeholders such as government counterparts (BAPPENAS, Ministry of Public Works, Ministry of Housing and Settlement, Ministry of Finance, and other line ministries as executing/concerned agencies) of the Government of Indonesia (GOI), other offices of JICA, JICA Experts, local consultants, Japanese consultants, development partners related.
- Update and analyze the impact of the changes of related local regulations/rules/news to the existing portfolio of JICA.
- Other duties as assigned.

Fields in charge:

The following is a list of fields that the PO is initially expected to be mainly in charge of the following sectors. The final assignment will be decided based on the candidate's suitability and other factors. It is important to note that the fields of responsibility may change in the future, depending on trends in JICA's operation and other factors. In other words, the PO's work may not be limited to the areas listed below.

- 1. Road and Bridge
- 2. Urban Planning
- 3. Housing and Settlement

Required Qualifications:

- Educational background: Bachelor's degree (S1) or higher education from a recognized university. Having a background of civil engineering or urban planning is preferable.
- Working experience: At least (3) three years of experience preferably on international development cooperation or government services. Experience in work related to Japan's ODA (Official Development Assistance) is preferable.

- Adaptable and willing to learn in the multi-cultural environment. Strong interest and good knowledge of development issues are advantageous. Willing to travel regionally.
- Good interpersonal/communication skill and strong analytical skills and problem solving.
- Good managerial skill
- Computer literacy in Microsoft Office and Outlook
- English fluency (both in speaking and writing). Proficiency of Japanese language is an advantage.
- Indonesian nationals residing in the Jakarta, Bogor, Depok, Tangerang, and Bekasi (Jabodetabek) area is eligible to apply.

Successful candidate will be offered a basic salary up to IDR.13,000,000, and other benefits including transportation allowance, BPJS, Private Health Insurance Program. *basic salary to commensurate with candidate's qualification and experience
