



Chief Representative's Message

Guided by the principles of human security and high-quality growth, JICA leverages Japan's developmental expertise to advance sustainable development. We prioritize local ownership and "co-creation" with global partners to address social issues through 20 strategic priorities aligned with the SDGs to build a more resilient and inclusive international community.

From the start of cooperation with Iran through fiscal year 2023, we have provided Iran with 46.1 billion JPY as ODA Loan and 32.106 billion JPY as technical cooperation expenses. This Technical Cooperation includes inviting about 3,870 Iranian technocrats to Japan for training and dispatching 1,492 experts and 2,308 study team members to Iran to support co-creation with Iranian officials, and provision of equipment totaling about 3.027 billion JPY. In addition, JICA is currently implementing or preparing grant aid projects amounting to approximately 2.871 billion JPY.

As Chief Representative since November 2025, my goal is to strengthen the foundation of mutual trust and collaborative partnership that has been built over years cooperation. By working closely with our Iranian partners, we remain committed to enhancing human security and fostering a prosperous, resilient future for all.

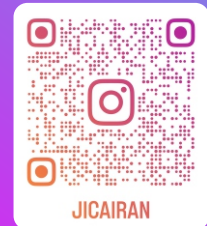
