

The Project for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS)

Project Purpose: The project is aimed to support human resource development of the recipient countries. It targets 20 young people with the status of public/municipal servants who are expected to participate as future leaders in the implementation of social and economic development policies. It offers Master's and Doctoral degree programs at Japanese universities in English. JDS Fellows will have the opportunity to acquire cutting-edge knowledge from Japan, as well as to build connections with representatives from other countries.

Project Period: From 2007 to present

Estimated Project Cost: annually approx. 308 million JPY (1 953 633 USD)*

Expected Outcomes:

- 1) Civil/municipal servants of Kyrgyzstan deepen their knowledge in a certain area and receive knowledge in the best Japanese universities. After coming back they implement it for development of Kyrgyzstan.
- 2) Public/municipal servants of Kyrgyzstan communicate and strengthen interaction with representatives of other countries.
- 3) Civil/municipal servants contribute to the strengthening of bilateral relations between Kyrgyzstan and Japan

Key Activities:

- Activities in Kyrgyzstan: Conducting promotional and recruiting events, collecting and reviewing applications, conducting technical and comprehensive interviews with candidates, conducting briefings for selected candidates and organizing reporting .
- Activities in Japan: Acquaintance with university life, study, tracking the learning process, other activities.
