

CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FOR TRANSITION TO THE NEW CNS/ATM SYSTEMS IN CAMBODIA, LAOS AND VIETNAM

Project period: January 2011 – December 2015

Project site: Cambodia, Laos and Vietnam

Project outline: The new Communication, Navigation Surveillance / Air Traffic Management (CNS/ATM) System utilizes satellite-based technologies in collaboration with ground navigation infrastructure, and on-board aircraft avionics, to maximize and increase the capabilities of its sub-systems. Furthermore the new CNS/ATM System is compatible with those being defined and specified by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

The project's expected outcomes are:

1. The development of Capacity to establish performance-based navigation flight procedures.
2. The development of a training system for air traffic controllers and air navigation technical staff on the new systems.
3. The strengthening of safety oversight capabilities through the introduction of safety management systems in air navigation services.
