Overview of Sector

- Necessity of improvement of health service in terms of quantity, quality and utilization
- High weight of health determinants, weak partnership: inter-sectorial, CSO, NGO, Private Sector.
- National Development Plan 2015–2035 aims for a reduction in Morbidity, the training of specialist doctors to respond to the Public Health Issues and focus on nutrition integrated interventions
- IIntegrated Development Plan for Infrastructure, Equipment, and Human Resources 2024–2044 aims promotes the healthcare system accessible and efficient, providing a quality of life for all citizens with sufficient and decent infrastructures, adequate, relevant, and updated equipment, and a sufficient, qualified, and motivated workforce.
 - Sector plan 2014–2019 extended to 2024 outlines ambition for better health services achieving universal health access, accelerating progress in the reduction of chronic malnutrition and reduction of maternal and neonatal mortality. To reform and decentralize as well as increase transparency and accountability in public resource usage
