A study of delayed Early Harvest Project

China Pakistan Economic Corridor is a flagship project of Belt & Road Initiative of China. In order to achieve the set goals of CPEC, China Pakistan mutually agreed to prioritize 22 projects out of total 51 projects. The research aimed at finding the reasons of delayed Early Harvest Projects (EHPs) of China Pakistan Economic Corridor and to judge the quality of institutions and policies dealing with those projects. The research is supported by the recent study on Official Development Assistance (ODA) that concludes that assistance effectiveness is best guaranteed through the quality of institutes dealing with the concerned projects and its policies. Further to test the hypothesis, the research questions were developed that emphasized the current status of delayed Early Harvest Projects and more precisely the reasons for delayed EHPs.

About the current status of EHPs the study found that in the first phase of CPEC plan, twelve are energy projects, nine of which are already operational, that have contributed 5320 MW of electricity to the main grid. The rest of the three delayed energy projects are also expected to be completed by the year 2022 and would pump in an additional 2190 MW to the national grid. The fourth delayed project is Eastbay expressway which is also expected to be completed by 2022. For the reasons of delays in project the common reason founds were issues like COVID-19, land acquisition, indigenous people's rights, transparency, misappropriation, and security. This revealed improper management and a lack of good governance.

There is substantial scope for improvement in governance in Pakistan. The emphasis has to be on achieving greater accountability of institutions. The instruments of the citizen scorecard and assessment by exports need to be used periodically to highlight areas of misgovernance
