On behalf of JICA, with the sincerest appreciation to our Japanese delegates, I declare that all of us are absolutely enthusiastic to contribute to the safe and reliable railway system modernization in the Philippines. As I reiterate on every occasion, let

us continue to work together to realize such "Japan-quality" public transportation systems in this beautiful country.
