

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) is looking for local organizations to conduct the project below. (The deadline for submission of requested documents has been extended to June 2nd, 2024 – Poland time)

Project Name: Data collection survey on improving the educational environment for Ukrainian refugee children and adolescent in Poland

Date of Advertisement – tentative: July, 2024

Project Period – tentative: August 2024 – January 2025

Essential experience:

- 1) At least two projects experience related to the Ukrainian refugees' support in the field of education
- 2) The budget size of each project above is approximately USD 64,000 or above.

Language to be used in communication: English

Background:

Due to the Russian invasion, many people living in Ukraine took refuge in surrounding countries. Poland, one of the neighboring countries of Ukraine, is the second largest refugee-hosting country among the EU countries. Ukrainian refugees who are allowed to hold the national identification number, PESEL number, have rights to access to Polish public service. Since the Russian Aggression is continuing, the burden borne by Poland has been increasing. The necessity to assist the host country, Poland is growing.

Regarding the educational situation of young Ukrainian refugees in Poland, the language barrier and insufficient supports for their studies and communications in schools are considered as a part of challenges. Whereas the burden on educational institutions is increasing because of the influx of Ukrainian refugees and the shortage of teachers, proposing further efforts to school staffs will give additional burden on them. Thus, to enhance sustainability, it would be important to explore the possibility of collaboration with private companies.

Purpose:

Through this survey with pilot activities, we will examine the educational situation of young Ukrainian refugees in Poland, as well as the possibility of collaboration with Japanese or Ukrainian private companies. The results of pilot activities will be analyzed, and the insights obtained will be used to make recommendations to the Ministry of Education and Science of Poland etc.

- 1) Brochures/documents which introduce your organization;
 - 2) Authorized project reports or any documents which prove that your organization/JV meets the “Essential experience” mentioned above;
 - 3) Information of projects expenses of 2) (please use the Appendix 1), and
 - 4) Official financial statement at least one most recent year.
- E.I. can be for both “Workshops for young Ukrainian refugees” and “Nostrification/Recognition of diploma for Ukrainian teachers in Poland”, or for either one.
 - JICA accepts E.I. from Joint Ventures (JV). In case of JVs, only the representative organization needs to meet the “Essential experience”.
 - Services that require specialized knowledge and expertise, e.g. teaching Polish language, may be allowed to subcontract after consultation with JICA.
 - JICA will evaluate the documents arrived before the deadline based on the previous experience, capacity/ability for the project implementation etc., and email only selected candidates for limited Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS)*.
- *A selection method adopted by JICA. The listed organizations are asked to submit a technical proposal and a financial proposal. After evaluation, JICA will choose partner(s) to make a contract. The details will be announced in July 2024.
