



Horticulture Value Chain Promotion Project (Phase 2) (ODA Loan)

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project supports the modernization and sustainable development of Uzbekistan's horticulture sector. The project improves access to long-term finance for horticultural producers and agribusinesses through two-step loans provided by Participating Financial Institutions (PFIs) to support investments in production, post-harvest handling, cold storage, processing, packaging, and logistics. It also includes technical assistance to strengthen agricultural financing and project implementation.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

Project supports improving financial access and strengthening horticulture value chain by/through supplying funds to horticulture crop growers and agro-related companies through the accredited PFIs, and by providing technical assistance for improving capacity of the PFIs, End-users and others, thereby contributing to the development of the agriculture sector through strengthening export capacity of horticulture crops together with employment promotion and income generation.
