



Health and Medical Service Improvement Project (ODA Loan)

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project includes constructing and equipping the Neurology and Stroke Center (NSC) in Tashkent, providing advanced medical equipment to the Bukhara State Medical Institute, the Multidisciplinary Clinic of Samarkand State Medical University, and the Multidisciplinary Specialized Center of Pediatric Surgery in Samarkand. Consulting services will also be provided for the project implementation and technical assistance for the hospital management. Utilizing advanced Japanese medical technologies under the Special Terms for Economic Partnership (STEP), the project will enhance the quality and accessibility of specialized healthcare services.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The project aims to strengthen medical services for non-communicable diseases, particularly neurological diseases and stroke, by constructing the Neurology and Stroke Center (NSC) and upgrading medical equipment in regional tertiary hospitals.
