PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project supports the institutional and research development of the Uzbek-Japan Innovation Center of Youth (UJICY), a joint research and innovation institution established in 2016 under Tashkent State Technical University. UJICY functions as a platform for promoting scientific research, innovation, and collaboration between academia and industry, particularly between Uzbekistan and Japan. Building on the achievements of the first phase, the project strengthens the Center's institutional management and research capacity to further develop it as a sustainable hub for innovation and co-creation.
