



Project for Strengthening Energy Conservation Capacity through the Establishment of an Energy Manager Scheme and Zero-Energy Building (ZEB) Demonstration Pilot Project (Technical Cooperation)

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The project supports the Government of Uzbekistan in promoting energy conservation and improving energy efficiency in the industrial and consumer sectors through institutional strengthening, human resource development, and technical assistance. A key feature of the project is the establishment of an Energy Manager Scheme and the implementation of a Zero-Energy Building (ZEB) demonstration pilot by renovating the administrative building of the S.A. Azimov Physics-Technical Institute of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan, demonstrating advanced energy-saving technologies suitable for wider application in the country.

The project aims to enhance the capacity for energy efficiency activities in the industrial and consumer sectors in Uzbekistan.
