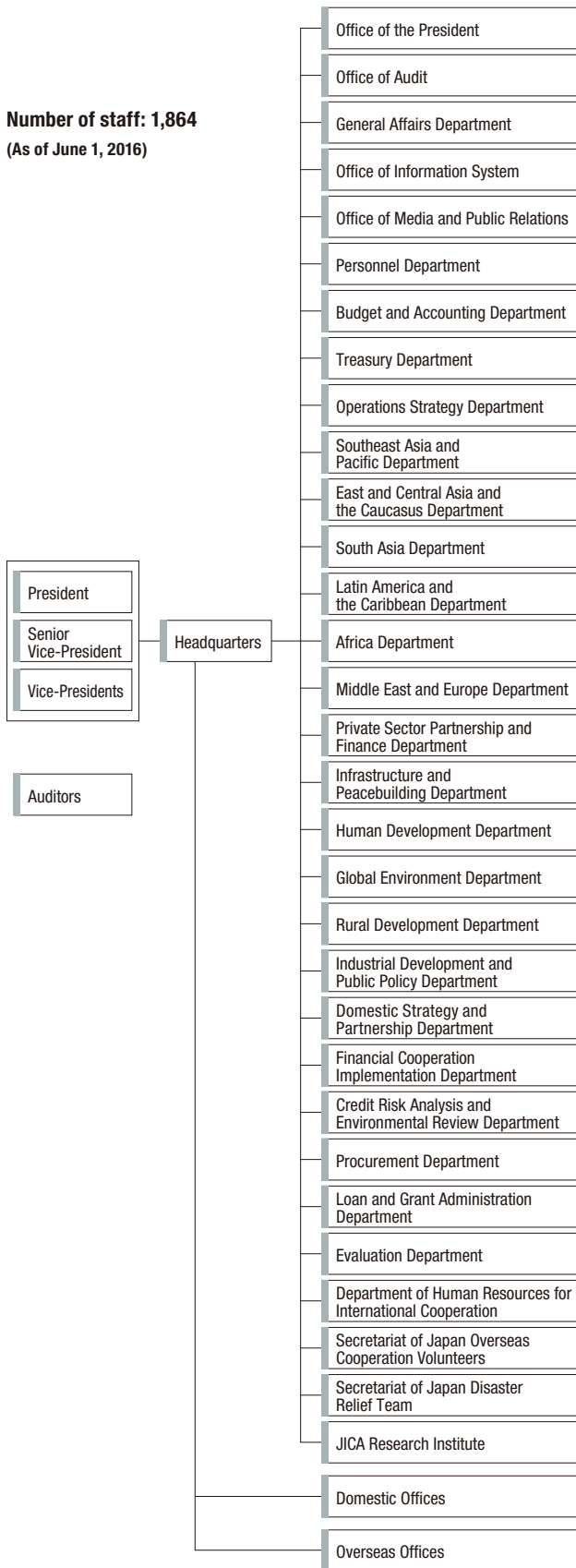


# Organization Chart / Executive Officers and Auditors

1. Number of executive officers and auditors: Pursuant to Article 7 of Act of the Incorporated Administrative Agency – Japan International Cooperation Agency, there shall be one President and three Auditors, and there may be one Senior Vice-President and up to eight Vice-Presidents.
2. Terms of office of executive officers and auditors: Pursuant to Article 21 of the Act on General Rules for Incorporated Administrative Agencies, the term of office of the President shall begin on the date of appointment and end on the last day of the Mid-Term Objective period concerned, while that of Auditors shall begin on the date of appointment and end on the date of approval of financial statements for the last business year of the Mid-Term Objective period concerned. Pursuant to Article 9 of Act of the Incorporated Administrative Agency-Japan International Cooperation Agency, the term of office of the President and Senior Vice-President shall be four years and the term of office of Vice-Presidents and Auditors shall be two years.
