Music teacher and Senior Volunteer from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Tadashi Nagatomi, is working in the Victoriano Lopez Music School in San Pedro Sula, Honduras through JICA's Volunteer Program.

Mr. Nagatomi, currently teaches piano as a secondary instrument, also teaches saxophone in free courses on weekends. His students' love to learn music is precisely his greatest satisfaction in teaching at this school. Mr. Nagatomi works in the creation of the piano class curriculum, with which he imparts to his students learning and interpretation of various musical pieces.

The Head Director of the School, Mr. Ernesto Rodriguez, shared that the school started in 1945 as a music academy, then in the 70's was recognized by the Ministry of Education as a school of music, starting with the Bachelor in Music, in which classes of language of music, history of music, instrument classes, orchestra and chorus classes, are taught.
