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Summary of Project

1.Background

Indonesia is one of leading countries in Southeast Asia where many attractive startups are born and grown. At the same time, there are numerous social issues remaining, and public funds alone are not enough to solve that. Therefore, JICA recognizes mobilizing private funds will be crucial to continuing to accelerate the national development of Indonesia. On this context, JICA has begun supporting growing social startups in Africa and Asia. JICA Indonesia office implemented a social startup acceleration program called NINJA (Next Innovation with Japan) for Indonesian Seed and Early-stage social startups from 2021 to 2023 in a more localized form to suit the needs of Indonesian social startups and the country's conditions. In 2024, the program will continue with a change of fields.

2. Objective

The purpose of this program is to accelerate the growth of Seed and Early-stage social startups that have the potential to contribute to achieving the SDGs in Indonesia. In order to do that, we will select three social startups, provide coaching on brushing up their business models and social impact assessment methods, and have them present the results at demo days to be held in Jakarta and Japan, and provide support for connecting with investors (VCs/Companies), including those in Japan. We will also hold an alumni meet where all the social startups that have been supported in this program to maintain and develop relationships with the startups.

This year, based on the JICA Global Agenda, we will focus on social startups that aim to solve social issues in the following fields.

- 1. Grren Transformation
- 2. Natural Environment and Conservation
- Sustainable Water Resources and Water Supply

And "University-Based social startups" will be set as encouraged applicants.
