1. The major objectives of the WG 2:

(REF: AKI ACTION PLAN (2022-2023) TOR for WG II: Standardization of Curriculum and Training Materials)

The major objectives of WG II are:

- 1. To visualize the skill set of Kaizen consultants defined in Kaizen Handbook;
- 2. To compare the defined skill set with the Kaizen consultant and training status of each country;
- 3. To summarize the issues, develop and horizontally deploy a program to fill the GAP between the current situation of member countries' Kaizen implementation and Kaizen Handbook.
- 4. To ensure the process of completing the standardized curriculum and training materials for Kaizen modules referring to the KAIZEN handbook.
- 5. To produce a suitable, applicable and acceptable recommendations on 'Standardized Kaizen/QPI Programs' for different scales of African Enterprises and economies as recommended in the KAIZEN Handbook.

2. The major tasks accomplished by the WG2:

The major tasks accomplished by the WG 2 as of September 2023 are:

Basic & Advanced KAIZEN:

- 1. Module I: Basic KAIZEN: 12/12 (100%) curriculums are developed as defined in the Kaizen Handbook;
- 2. Module II: Advanced KAIZEN: 11/12 (92%) curriculums are developed as defined in the Kaizen Handbook after monthly meetings.

In total: 95% of curriculums were successfully developed.

Business management (BDS) :


Module III & IV: Class Room Training, (CRT & ICT) In Company Training are well achieved (100%) on June 1st, 2023 in TUNISIA by the Japanese Expert: Mr. Yasunobu Kakiuchi San/JPC & JICA team. The training material as wells as curriculum were 100% developed.

3. The expected outputs of the WG 2:


The expected outputs of the WG2 are:

- 1. The outputs such as detailed curriculums of KAIZEN Module I & II were developed through discussions and WG 2 monthly meetings.
- 2. The curriculum & materials of KAIZEN Module III & IV were developed through the implementation of the pilot program activities. They will be shared among African partners for promoting the mutual learning.
- 3. The scope and expected outcome which was shown in the initial TOR of WG 2 are: Produce a suitable, standardized, applicable and acceptable Kaizen/QPI services for different scales/categories (MSEs, MLEs) and economies (Agriculture, Industry, Services).

4. The deliverables achieved by the WG 2:

The deliverables achieved by the WG2 & the Japanese KAIZEN Experts are:

- 1. The detailed curriculums of KAIZEN Module I were achieved at 100%: 12 standardized curriculums.
- 2. The detailed curriculums of KAIZEN Module II were achieved at 92%: 11 standardized curriculums.
- 3. The developed materials and curriculums of the Business management Modules III & IV were developed at 100% by the Japanese KAIZEN expert: Basics of Management, Critical Thinking, HRM & Organizational Behavior, Accounting, Marketing, Strategic Planning, Business Development, with improved corporate diagnosis skills.

5. The major challenges faced by the WG 2:

The major challenges faced by the WG 2 are:

- 1. To motivate the team members of the WG 2;
- 2. To inspire the WG 2 team members to produce a high level of standardized curriculums;
- 3. To ensure the hole participation, the success and the certification of 18 KAIZEN master trainers and 04 companies in the CRT & the ICT under the framework of pilot program in Tunisia.
- 4. To maintain and to improve the quality level of the KAIZEN expertise already received.
- 5. To finalize and to share the detailed curriculums developed.

6. The countermeasures taken by the WG 2:

The countermeasures taken by the WG 2 & the secretariat :

- 1. Telling the team members of the WG 2 the specific and the immediate goals;
- 2. Limiting the time available for the Curriculums to be developed;
- 3. Sharing the load of monthly deadlines within the sacrifice of motivated members & leaders;
- 4. Appealing the positive emotions like the sense of the African belonging & business consulting opportunities with the thrill of achievement by certification;
- 5. Improving & reviewing all the developed curriculums continuously by the Japanese Experts from JICA & JPC;
- 6. Ensuring the participation of the motivated members to the coming AKAC 2023 in ETHIOPIA.

7. The WG 2 self-evaluation of our achievements.

The WG 2 self-evaluation of our achievements:

- ✓ Quantitatively :
- 100% the deadlines & the outputs are rigorously respected especially in 2023 but less active members of WG 2 with more than 80% of presenteeism.

✓ Qualitatively :

The Voice of the final customers is already heard after the trial training in TUNISIA with 100% of companies satisfaction announced (04 companies from several fields). However more training especially in Accounting modules will be

appreciated.

8. The recommendations of the WG 2 to implement the deliverables and issues to be considered during AKI-AP 2024-2027.

- ✓ The WG 2 recommendations to implement the deliverables are :
 - Accelerate the rhythm of standardized curriculum development by better motivation & delegation to the active & engaged WG members;
 - Work on the customization and quality improvement of all curriculums to ensure the success of the mutual learning phase by adequate tools of training materials depending on final customers needs.
- ✓ The issues to be considered during AKI-AP 2024-2027 are :
 - To learn from the different key final customers requirements when developing the KAIZEN standard curriculums : able to be customized to ensure a high value added and profits as a strategic advantages.
