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
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1. Inception and Important Milestones

 under MIDI, MOI




2. KEC Overview












3.2. Kaizen Implementation Flow Diagram


6.1. Training Service

- ✓ About 5 billion ETB saved as monetary value














National Kaizen Award established in 2012 (2005EC) and given every two years EKI established in 2011. EKI received JICA President Award in 2015
