This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that was published in Development Business Online website, Reference No. IDB1659-12/17 of December 22, 2017.

The Petroleum Corporation of Jamaica (PCJ) acting on behalf of the Government of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and European Union-Caribbean Investment Facility (EU-CIF) toward the cost of the Energy Management and Efficiency Programme (EMEP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the contracting of works and services. Bidding will be governed by the Bank's and the European Union eligibility rules and procedures.

The PCJ now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the supply and installation of an Urban Traffic Management System in the Kingston Metropolitan Region.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's: *Policies for the Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank*, GN-2349-9, the EU Rules on participation in procurement procedures and grants ([PRAG](#)) annex A2a, and the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) Public Sector Procurement Procedures, and is open to all eligible and qualified bidders as defined in the Inter-American Development Bank policies and the European Union eligibility rules and procedures.

Bidders eligible to participate are those who are nationals of member countries of the IDB and EU eligible countries.

All bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security of US\$30,000.00 or J\$3,900,000.00.

Late bids will be rejected and returned to the bidder unopened.
