# **5** Clinic for Medical Consultation




For JICA participants, JICA Kyushu has a medical consultation room on the walk-in basis to which general practitioner attends once a week for minor and non-emergency medical consultation.

10:30 - 17:45 Monday through Friday except doctors' visiting days (attended by Medical coordinator)


11:30 - 18:45 medical doctor and psychiatrist's visiting days


JICA Kyushu will not lend laptops to training participants.

# **Accommodation Building**





Accommodation building is also equipped with laundry room on each floor. Use of washing machine and dryer is free and irons are available in the front desk when needed.

Cooking facility is not available and cooking in the room is strictly prohibited, microwave oven is available on each accommodation floor for your convenience.


# Life in JICA Kyushu ~Room~


