- Commencement of the installation work of Steel Structures: columns and beams for new powerhouse
- Casting concrete for foundation girder, ground floor slab, column, roof girder and roof slab of new pump house, Radiator foundation slab, and Transformer foundation
- Installation of foundations for Heavy Fuel Oil pipe inside the LEC Bushrod Compound.
