



President Sirleaf visits Rehabilitation for Monrovia Power Plant Rehabilitation Project in Bushrod

On 16th June, President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf paid a visit to Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) facilities in Bushrod Island.

The visit was intended to assess Progress in developments in LEC power plant rehabilitation projects which is funded by donors including World Bank and Japan. Prior to the opening ceremony by World Bank which was held on 17th June, the President visited Japan funded powerhouse construction site and was briefed by LEC executives and Japanese experts on current progress.
