
## Project for Automotive Supply Chain Development in Mexico

## **Project Outline**

#### [Overall Goal]

Mexican automotive supply chain is strengthened.

#### [Project Purpose]

Mechanisms for developing the automotive supply chain between Japanese auto component suppliers (Tier-1) and local auto parts suppliers (Tier-2) are strengthened.

#### [Outputs]

<u>Output 1:</u> Potential local auto parts suppliers (Tier-2) are systematically and smoothly recommended to model Japanese auto component suppliers (Tier-1).

<u>Output 2:</u> Competitiveness of local auto parts suppliers (Tier-2) is sufficiently enhanced to involve the supply chain of the Japanese auto producers.

<u>Output 3:</u> Participating local auto parts suppliers (Tier-2) enhance their understandings of Japanese business practice.

<u>Output 4:</u> Opportunities for business matching between Japanese auto component suppliers (Tier-1) and potential local auto parts suppliers (Tier-2) are increased.


