First INSET in Kampong Cham and Second Session in Battambang

The In-Service Training (INSET) for nurses has continued to make consistent progress in both pilot provinces, Battambang and Kampong Cham.

In Battambang, the second session was held from 8th to 9th, covering Basic Nursing Skills (2 days, 30 participants) and Communication (2 days, 33 participants). As this was the second implementation in the province, the Provincial Training Management Team (PTMT) carried out the preparation and facilitation more smoothly than in the previous round, reflecting the steady progress of the handover of training management from the Project to the provincial team.

In Kampong Cham, the first INSET was conducted from 22nd to 23rd, featuring Nursing Ethics (1.5 days, 27 participants) and Communication (2 days, 33 participants). The courses were organized at two venues—the Provincial Health Department and the Provincial Hospital—which posed some coordination challenges for the PTMT. However, after the training, the PTMT held a review meeting with the Project team to share the challenges and identify practical measures for improvement. The next INSET courses are scheduled for late November, and further enhancement in the training management is expected based on the lessons learned from this initial experience.

Meetings on the E-Learning Platform with MoH IT Team and JICA HQ Consultant

The Project held a series of meetings with both the JICA Headquarters IT consultant and the Ministry of Health (MoH) IT teams to discuss the improvement and future management of the E-Learning Platform (ELP).

Two meetings with the JICA HQ IT consultant were held on 6th and 24th. The discussions reviewed the current operation of the E-Learning Platform (ELP), which has been in use since September 2024, supporting the third round of the Training of Trainers (ToT3) conducted between December 2024 and June 2025, as well as the ongoing INSET implementation in the pilot provinces. Through actual operation, the Project and the Human Resource Development Department (HRDD) identified several functions that require technical modification. The consultant has been assisting the Project in analyzing these issues, and, in coordination with HRDD and the MoH IT team, a plan for system improvement is expected to be finalized around the end of this year.

In addition, three meetings were held with the HRDD IT team on 14th, 20th, and 31st to discuss usability, team roles, and the operation and management of the ELP. The last meeting included newly assigned IT officers from the Department of Digital Health and Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, marking the beginning of cross-departmental collaboration under the Ministry's shared direction for the sustainable management of the platform.
