arious cadre participating in the 2025 Know, Co-Creation Program (KCCP) in Japan from January 14th to January 31st joined various Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) teams in Chawama, Chilenje and Matero first level hospitals (FLH) to acquaint and familiarize themselves with the tools used as well as understand how the IPC teams work and how the hospital departments are implementing IPC protocols.

On November 11th, 2024, the Lusaka Provincial Health Office (LPHO) Chief Environmental Health Officer (CEHO), Ms. Cathel Chiboola and Mr. Aaron Kabwe, Medical Equipment Technologist (MET) at Matero FLH joined Mr. Kankoloto (EHT) and the rest of the IPC team in conducting the team's 4th IPC round.

Speaking of their experience, Ms. Chiboola and Mr. Kabwe both stated how the rounds were enlightening and showed the need for collaboration between the IPC team and the MET departments as well-maintained equipment adds to the care provided to and received by patients.

In a visit to Chawama on November 14th, Lusaka District Health Office (LDHO)

Head of Clinical Care (HCC) Dr. Choolwe Sianchapa, LDHO MET Mr. Friday Matafwali and LPHO Chief Nursing Office (CNO) Ms. Inutu Mbangweta accompanied the IPC team conducting their 3rd hospital IPC rounds. Joined by Mr. Darius Mulenga (MET), departmental IPC champions and heads of departments (HOD) were delighted to have an audience with the LDHO HCC and LPHO CNO and facility Matron Ms. Lorraine Chikonka as they were able to share with them directly issues affecting each of the departments.

The visitors were impressed with how the Chawama FLH IPC team does their job and how the departments are implementing the introduced protocols in infection prevention as well as the collaboration between the team and the MET department.

Participants overall expressed their appreciation to be allowed to take part in the rounds and stated that the exercise was timely and would be helpful as they prepared for the KCCP whose theme 'Japan's approach and experience in strengthening hospital management (Infection Prevention and Control, and Medical Equipment Management)'.

Long term experts such as the Chief Advisor of the JICA Cassiopeia Project in Zambia are sent by NCGM: previously, Dr. Masataro Norizuki since the inception of the project to May 2024 and the current chief, Dr. Shinsuke Murai, being dispatched by the NCGM.

The doctors visited Zam-

bia as JICA partners to see the Cassiopeia project to which the organization has deployed experts. They visited one of the project sites, Kanyama Hospital, for a field visit.

During the visit, Dr. Miyamoto and Dr. Fujita toured the labor, post-natal, out-patient, pharmacy and satellite pharmacy departments.

Dr. Nzolo and the various heads of departments shared with the visitors the issues they face during the course of their duties but also shared some of the protocols they had implemented such as 5S and infection prevention and control protocols. Dr. Rosemary Kabale, the Head of Clinical Care (HCC) also explained how the hospital has incorporated the Balanced Scorecard into the hospital's planning and how

it is helping to strengthen the hospital's management capacity. Dr. Miyamoto and Dr. Fujita noted how the staff in Kanyama FLH work around the clock without interruption, and remarked that this good practice is the result of the continous efforts of the management and all staff members. In a discussion with Dr Simuruyamana Choonga, Director of the Lusaka Provincial Health Office, Dr Miyamoto exchanged views on the path to documenting the good practices of the hospital in a hospital management handbook as one of the products of the project. The project now needs to develop a plan to shape the Hospital Management Handbook by May 2025.
