Main Activity

The main activity was the distribution of items such as food packs and clothing in order to provide for the homeless and less fortunate in the community. These donated items, which were sent by overseas church members, were channeled through the South Pacific Division and the CPUM. ADRA Fiji has worked closely with the Central Pacific Union Mission (now Transpacific Union Mission) and the Fiji Mission since 1989 to provide humanitarian assistance, repair buildings damaged by cyclones, connect students with donor supporters, respond to natural disaster crises, and initiate development projects.

Disaster Risk Management

With the support of the French Government ADRA Fiji ensured Naqali operates inclusive evacuation centre.



This project included Retrofitting of EC to become disability friendly. improving the adaptive capacities of women and girls (youth) to withstand multiple hazards, recover from disasters, and increase their resilience to current and future risks in vulnerable communities in Fiji.

Economic Development in Vanua Levu

Supported by USAID's flagship small grant facility, the Pacific American Fund, ADRA Fiji through the LEAP project enhanced the quality of lives in Vanua Levu, Fiji. This project did not only improve the quality of life for 50 local communities by improving food security and economic opportunities, but it has also enhanced their ability to adapt to the growing impacts of climate change.

Clean Running Water For Naleba

Justice, Compassion & Love are the values that drive ADRA in their humanitarian and development work in more than 120 countries worldwide. For almost a year, the water supply in this drought prone area was affected after the concrete tank sustained damage and could no longer store water for the community.
