Habitat for Humanity Fiji was founded as a non-profit charitable trust in Fiji in 1991. We have been repairing and building homes for lower income families ever since.

In addition, since 2009 we have assisted hundreds of families in disaster response. Our disaster recovery program has grown from strength to strength. Providing new homes, as well as repairing damaged homes, and community water systems. Emergency repairs to cyclone- damaged homes in informal settlements.

Main Activity

Since 2009, HFH Fiji has provided Housing and WASH assistance to communities in need and those impacted by natural disasters through repairs and temporary housing solutions and WASH services. HFH Fiji believes that the provision of adequate housing and safe water drinking water are fundamental human rights and that the dignity that comes with secure housing tenure and water access are the key to breaking



the poverty cycle for many low-income and marginalized households. We believe that improving the living conditions is a “hand-up” instead of a “hand-out”
