During the COVID-19 pandemic, pop-up testing and immunization clinics emerged as a significant innovation, operating efficiently in publicly accessible spaces.

Staffed by volunteers, doctors, and nurses, these clinics provided several benefits:

- Relieving medical practitioners to concentrate on urgent cases.
- Ensuring accessibility regardless of location or mobility.
- Enabling patients to receive services conveniently from their vehicles.
- Minimizing interaction hassle and long queues and addressing fears of visiting medical practices during a pandemic.
