SUPPORT TO SOUTH-SOUTH COOPERATION IN MALAYSIA

Since 1983 JICA started the support to South-South Cooperation (SSC) in Malaysia, JICA has expanded its partnership with the Government of Malaysia through SSC. In 1992, a Joint Third Country Training Programme (TCTP) was initiated with the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP). Since 2002, TCTP has been implemented on 50-50 cost sharing basis between MTCP and JICA.


MAJOR INSTRUMENTS

The major part of JICA's support to South-South Cooperation is the Third Country Training Program (TCTP) scheme, which includes the Group Type of multiple target countries and the Country-Focused Type of a single target country.



STRENGTHS

The Third Country Training Program (TCTP) is a cooperation program that effectively utilizes the know-how, human resources, and human resource network accumulated in Malaysia through Japan's long years of cooperation. The combination of Malaysia's strengths with Japan's knowledge and network will be very useful for other developing countries.

The Third Country Training Program (TCTP) for Palestine, in cooperation with the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP), has been conducted since 2012.
