- **Project Overview:** The trilateral project consists of exchange of successful experiences, information, documents between Brazil and Mozambique in the various health services.



Development Issues / Background

- JICA assessed the demand in Hospital Management System (HMS) and identified complicated factors: (1) **Technical** (lack of standards data entry and data retrieval, these cause difficulties in training), (2) **Human** (few awareness of hospital management advantages causing less efficiency of knowledge utilization for HMS).
 - In line these challenges, MISAU is in process of the revision and development of the technical guidelines as a part of the capacity development cooperation to facilitate the standardization of HMS.

Expected Impact on the Health Sector

- Maputo Central Hospital (HCM) assimilate the hospital management quality control in the area of Neonatology, Imageology and Pediatric.
- MISAU and HCM shares responsibilities in the operationalization of a formal urgency and emergency regulation mechanism.
- MISAU benefited from the exchange of information, reviews and documents on hospital management.
