National Development Plan 2015–2035 focuses on HR training and Retention with focus on Sciences




National Investment Plan 2020–2024 aims for the construction of 200 secondary schools and 3355 classrooms coupled with teacher training programs and a textbook development program



Sector plan 2019–2029 to assure inclusive and equal access for participation and retention, learning quality and a transparent, participative, efficient and effective governance






JICA's Approach
