1. Report of the second half of 2024

We wish you a Happy and Peaceful New Year, 2025. We have had a variety of activities in Papua New Guinea last year as well. Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) PNG Office sincerely appreciates all the people who cooperated in our activities and the people of Japan for their kind supports.

As of January 2025, we have the projects and activities ongoing in PNG in cooperation with our PNG counterparts as follows: 2 Loan Projects, 10 Technical Cooperation Projects (1 under preparation to launch), 3 Individual Expert Projects, 16 JICA Volunteers, 1 Private Sector Cooperation Survey, 1 Cultural Grant Aid Project and 2 Grant Aid Projects (under preparation). Furthermore, 44 Long term trainees have been currently studying at universities in Japan.

The following is the report of the progresses and achievements of the second half of 2024.

(1) 50th anniversary of Japan's ODA to PNG!

Japan's Official Development Assistance (ODA) to PNG started in 1974 and the year 2024 marked the 50th anniversary. On 17 October, the ceremony was coorganized by the Government of PNG, the Embassy of



Japan, and JICA.

others from the PNG government, foreign missions, UN organizations, universities, business communities, civil societies, etc. The event was covered by the media and that gave valuable opportunities to let the people of PNG know about the outcomes of Japan's ODA by today and its roles to deepen the ties between both countries.

Mr. Hataeda, Senior Vice President of JICA, mentioned in his speech, "With our Vision, Leading the World with Trust, JICA continues its cooperation with PNG to tackle the challenges in this country." Hon. Marape mentioned in his speech that Japan, which had started its support in PNG one year before the independence, is the sincere and genuine friend and said, "We continue our cooperation and expand it more in business partnership as well".

(2) PNG participated in PALM 10 in Tokyo

In the 10th Pacific Islands Leaders Meeting (PALM 10)



held in Tokyo from 16 to 18 July, the mission from PNG, headed by PM Hon. Marape, participated. On 18 July, Hon. Marape met with Dr. Tanaka, the President of JICA,

and expressed his deep appreciation to Japan's 50-year ODA to PNG and had discussions with Dr. Tanaka about further cooperation in future.

(3) Mr. Will Genia visited JICA PNG

On 28 August, Mr. Will Genia, the world's famous rugby player, visited JICA PNG Office. Mr. Genia has been playing at a Japanese professional rugby team, Hanazono Kintetsu Liners, since 2019 after having had his careers in Australia and France. His surprising visit was realized with the kind cooperation of Hanazono Kintetsu Liners as part of our PR activities of the 50th anniversary of Japan's ODA to PNG.



After being briefed about JICA's activities at JICA PNG Office, he visited Sogeri Primary School where JICA volunteers were working and observed



(4) A new scholarship project, JDS, launched

On 22 August, the Grant Agreement (G/A) was signed by the Department of National Planning and Monitoring and JICA for a new grant aid project, "the Project for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS)".



In this project, government officials of PNG will learn at post graduate

schools of Japan. These scholars are expected to contribute to economic and social development of PNG as well as deepening the ties between PNG and Japan in future. Approximately 15 PNG government officials are expected to learn in Japan annually in this project.

(5) Public Investment Management to be improved

On 16 August, Department of National Planning and Monitoring (DNPM) and JICA signed on the Record of Discussions (R/D) to start a new technical cooperation project, "Public Investment Management Project".

Based on the dispatch of an individual expert in the past, this project aims to improve public investment management and its transparency in formulation, selection, and monitoring of public investment projects with DNPM and other relating government organizations according to the Public Investment Program Management Guidelines.

(6) Partnership with Eisai Co., Ltd. to fight LF

On 18 September, Dr. Yamauchi (on the left of the



photo), the Chief Advisor of "Project for Elimination of Lymphatic Filariasis Phase 2" visited Eisai Co., Ltd. in Tokyo. Eisai donates the

drug called diethylcarbamazine (DEC), which is used for mass drug administration (MDA) in this project.

Dr. Yamauchi explained the progresses and the next steps of the project and received information from the staff in charge of the Sustainability Department of the company about the experiences of MDA in other countries and shipping status of the drugs to PNG.

JICA sincerely appreciates Eisai Co., Ltd. for its generous support to the project and we will continue to exchange information closely.

(7) TC in gravel road maintenance finishes

On 28 August, a Joint Coordinating Committee meeting of the technical cooperation project, "Capacity Development of Road Maintenance Phase 2", was held to confirm the achievements of the project. JICA has been carrying out its technical cooperation with the Department of Works and Highways for 7 years to improve the capacity of maintenance of gravel roads in 8 pilot provinces. Although this project will end in March 2025, it is expected that the PNG government will continue to maintain its roads based on the achievement of the projects.

(8) Japanese schoolteachers visited PNG

From 29 July to 2 August, 10 Japanese school teachers from various prefectures visited PNG. In this program, these teachers observed Japan's ODA project sites and had discussions with people in education sector in PNG including the Department of National Education. These teachers are expected to promote international cooperation and understanding in their educational activities in their schools.

(9) Workbooks to improve math ability of students



JICA carried out a technical cooperation project from 2016 to 2020 in which math and science textbooks from G3 to 6 were developed for the first time in PNG. A Japanese textbook company,

Gakko Tosho Co., Ltd, which had been involved in this project, also developed math workbooks to supplement the textbooks under JICA's Private Sector Cooperation. On 5 September, a seminar was co-organized by Department of National Education and JICA in which many people in education sector participated. It is expected these workbooks will support students of PNG to improve their mathematics skills.

students at Pre-service teachers' college since 2020. During the past 3 years, the knowledge and capacity of my counterparts (CPs) have improved, and we could have developed quality materials for teaching, which have been finalized and used at the teaching fields.

My career in PNG started in 1990, when I was assigned as a JICA Volunteer at Skul Bilong Wokim Piksa (National Film Institute) in Eastern Highlands Province. I really enjoyed working with my enthusiastic CPs and learning the rich culture of PNG. I was also fascinated by my Papua New Guinean friends who accepted me as their family, and great nature and traditions of PNG, that made me decide to work for the development of PNG. Fortunately, after my assignment as a JICA Volunteer, I could continue to work as a Senior Volunteer at NDOE and Chief Adviser of Technical Cooperation projects in education sector. In 2015, I was extremely honored with a Meritorious Public Service Medal, MPS. This year is the 35th year since I started my career in PNG. I hope to keep working with my CPs to improve the education in PNG.
