These participants contributed towards formulating drafts for teaching manuals under this training for the project "Strengthening Primary Teacher Pre-Service Education (STEPMAS).

### **Project/Training Details**

This online-training provided participants with special pedagogical knowledge of Math & Science and children's learning process by Naruto University of Education from Japan in collaboration with JICA, DHERST & NDoE. Participants were expected to draft training materials & instruction books which will be utilized in teacher's college in PNG for enhancing the way to teach based on Standard Based Curriculum (SBC) national text book & teachers manuals in Math and Science (Grade 3-6), which were developed in QUISME\* project.

JICA also supports increased involvement of women in JICA's trainings and projects. Therefore, JICA aims to increase the number of female participants to similar trainings from 2021 onwards.
