Development Issues / Background

- In Mozambique, food insecurity is 24% (2013) and nearly half of children aged 0-5 years old still suffer from chronic malnutrition.
- On the Tokyo Nutrition Summit 2021 (N4G) held in 2021, Mozambican government committed to reduce chronic malnutrition among children aged 0-5 years old from 38% in 2020 to 30% in 2030, the development of nutrition guidelines by 2030, and the allocation of at least 10% of the national budget to the agricultural sector every year until 2025.

Expected Impact on the Nutrition Sector

- Improvement of nutrition support coordination in cooperation with related ministries and development partners through SETSAN's multi-sectoral efforts.
