Dry Season Cultivation almost finished and started to prepare for Next Rainy Season

Output 1: Cultivation Technics

1. Regular Monitoring Activities

We continued growth monitoring and advised the FFS farmers and extension workers about appropriate harvest timing.



2. Harvest of Dry Season Cultivation

Among FFS farmers, all 25 farmers in Buluto and 40 out of 42 farmers in Maliana



succeeded to harvest their paddies until the end of October.

3. Harvest Training and Yield Components Survey



We conducted harvest training and yield components survey together with extension workers.

4. Preparation for the Coming Rainy Season Cultivation

We discussed next season's plan with MAF municipal offices and were selecting lead farmers for the next FFS.

Output 2: Irrigation Water Management

1. Canal Monitoring

We continued to monitor water level of Buluto and Maliana I irrigation schemes. Water level were increased after some rain in the mountain areas.

We continued to support the Buluto WUA to discuss how to share the collected water fee among WUA and Kabu-we.

2. CAAKUB's Membership Socialization





The purpose of this membership program is to strengthen both quantity and quality of paddies which CAAKUB will purchase. 62 farmers from 4 groups have registered so far.

Output 4: Purchasing and Distribution (Government Sector)

1. NLC's Payment to Farmers in Buluto

We followed up NLC's payment, but unfortunately NLC could not complete payment to the farmers groups in Buluto who sold their paddies to NLC in last August due to incompletion of internal document.

2. Survey on Surrounding Areas of Maliana I



We have conducted a survey on 5 villages surrounding Maliana I (red circle) in order to know their rice production and sales conditions, also to share NLC's purchase operation.
