Project continued FFS WS with extension workers mainly on weeding and topdressing in Maliana I and on transplanting and weeding in Buluto. On Feb 25, 4 staffs of ACELDA company also joined WS to understand more about Good Agricultural Practice (GAP) and spread to their membership farmers.

Because of constant and enough rain in both project sites, the growth of rice was favorable. We continue to guide the farmers for appropriate transplanting, weeding, and topdressing.

Output 3: Distribution and Sales (Private Sector)

1. CAAKUB Farmers Association Membership Program



Project continued to measure land size by GPS for 176 farmers who registered membership, in collaboration with Output 1. Based on the measured land size, CAAKUB started to distribute fertilizers to the farmers.

2. ACELDA company's Membership Program



Project were measuring 117 farmers' paddy fields by GPS under the collaboration with Output 1. Based on measured land size, ACELDAcompany distributed fertilizers to the farmers.





Output 4: Purchasing and Distribution (Government Sector)

1. Socialization on Paddy Purchase by National Logistic Center (NLC) in surrounding areas in Manatuto



NLC with Project conducted the socialization in surrounding areas in Manatuto on 23, 25, and 26 February. Around 50 farmers attended for each socialization.



2. Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for paddy purchase by NLC

Project make draft of SOP based on paddy purchase in 2020. Project and NLC will discuss and modify the draft to be used in the next paddy purchase.

3. Establishment of Rice Task Force It seems that takeover on this task force within each related ministry has not been done successfully. Therefore, we will launch a meeting for the establishment of rice task force as soon as possible.
