

Arrangement for the exchange visit

Overall preparation

- Inform farmers that you are **representative of the communities** so that it is important to **give feedback** to the community.
- Ask farmers to decide **at least one farming technique or knowledge** (including nursery management, spacing, crop rotation) **to demonstrate/share** in your field (small plot like one bed is ok).
- If necessary, ask **DAs to take photos** to share the same ideas in their communities

Field visit pre-preparation

- Before visiting the fields, provide an **“exchange visiting sheet”** (refer to the sheet) and let them try to fill this paper with DAs. (project will provide scale for body measurement)
- **Each DA should support 2 to 3 farmers** and **each DA should fill the paper**, but farmers can measure the plant spacing or ask questions to the owners

After Field visit

- Prepare flip charts and paper. Provide the following paper to the DAs
- Ask farmers **what they learned through this field visit**. Write it down until the comments exhaust
- Ask farmers **which technologies/knowledge they can apply** in their place. **Check those contents by red pen**
- Ask farmers **to raise their hands** which one they want to demonstrate from the one which checked in the previous session
- Let DAs to **write farmer’s name** and **what they are going to do**.
- Let each target site discuss and decide **when they can organize feedback session** to the communities.
