Last June and July, Education Forum was held in Oti, Volta and Eastern region with the participation of the representatives of SMC federations, Regional Education office and the District education offices. During the education forum, the results of the mathematics examinations were presented, and the participants agreed to make an effort to improve children's performance. As one of the attempts, remedial classes were started in the three regions. During the summer vacation, children come to school and study at their own pace with the assistance of community facilitators.

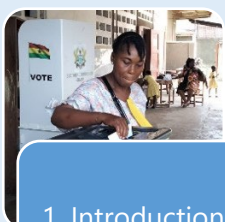
1,860 schools in Volta, Oti and Eastern region (Approx 13,000 teachers and 440,000 pupil).

Main interventions by the Project



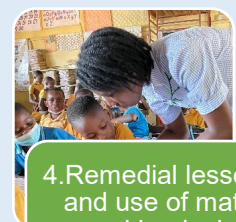
1. Introduction of SMC democratic election
