Mid-term evaluation and further activities

The Project has conducted training and surveys with the aim of implementing AUTP (agricultural insurance for paddy) and strengthening its implementation so that small-scale rice farmers can continue to engage in agriculture even when they are severely damaged by natural disaster, pests and so on.



Plans for the second half

In the latter half of the Project, the Project will; 1. Promote the establishment of a decision making body for agricultural insurance that brings together related agencies and organizations 2. Develop materials and human resources in the target areas (East Java Province and South Sulawesi Province) so that AUTP will be more widely known and implemented. 3. Implement feasibility study for Area Yield Index Insurance, in West Java Province.
