## Wrap-up Workshops Held in AYII (Area Yield Index Insurance) Pilot Districts

The pilot activities of AYII (Area Yield Index Agricultural Insurance) for paddy have been implemented in Kendal District, Central Java Province and Karawang District, West Java Province. The wrap-up meetings were held at each district to review the implementation and progress to date. In Kendal, it was

the first trial of AYII, only 156 hectares and 360 farmers were enrolled against a target of 1000 hectares. On the other hand, Karawang was the third crop season trial, with 646 hectares and 448 farmers enrolled against the same target registration. Along with the report by each Agriculture

Department, the workshops were held to review the pilot activities process of the AYII and discussed finding a resolution and improvement against the issues and difficulty in each step. These results and recommendations will be reflected in the upcoming revisions of the AYII guidelines by the Ministry of Agriculture and also related manuals so that the regional staff can implement AYII with a better understanding and to refer to the tools in the field.



## 9<sup>th</sup> JCC and Workshop on Agricultural Insurance

The 9th JCC (Joint Coordinating Committee) meeting was held on 31 October. A total of 46 participants attended including the representatives from the project implementing agencies and the agricultural departments of the pilot sites. The meeting was chaired by the Project director, Dr. Vivi Yulaswati, Acting Deputy Minister of BAPPENAS (National Development Planning Agency), who presented the project progress and plan toward the project completion in June 2023. Puslatan (Agricultural Training Centre) of the Ministry of Agriculture presented their regular training program for agriculture extension officers and agreed to add sessions on AUTP (Indemnity based agricultural insurance for paddy) on top of the scheduled two online courses within 2022. In addition, Puslatan will call for a coordination meeting by the end of this year to plan the details of having the AUTP training module be a part of their regular training program for year 2023. Regarding with AYII, it was also agreed that all tools and materials developed under the Project will either be attached to or referred by the official guideline of AYII implementation for year 2023 to be revised and issued by Ministry of Agriculture within this year. Before the JCC, stakeholders from the agricultural insurance sector were invited and exchanged views on the workshop theme: "Challenges and Opportunities of Agricultural Insurance in Indonesia"; their inputs and insights will be reflected in the policy recommendations to be produced by the project early next year.
