C.1 ILHZ Coordinator/District Health Manager Roles and Functions (2)

C.1 ILHZ Coordinator/District Health Manager: Roles and Functions (4)

- Advocate for ILHZ needs with component municipal Local Chief Executive (LCEs), Provincial Health Office (PHO) and Center for Health Development (CHD); and
- Facilitate communication within the ILHZ and between the ILHZ, PHO and CHD.

C.1 ILHZ Coordinator/District Health Manager Roles and Functions (3)


- Assist key municipal and NGO personnel to develop collaborative health management systems within the ILHZ;

- Coordinate ILHZ planning, monitoring and evaluation activities and reporting;


C.2 ILHZ Coordinator/District Health Manager (5)

Benguet Experience: A. Setting Up the ILHZ Office (1)

- The Inter-local Health Zone Office/ District
 Health Office somehow strengthened the identity
 of the ILHZ.
- Benguet ILHZ Office spaces are also being utilized for the following purposes:
 - depository of ILHZ documents and office equipment
 - venue for ILHZ Board/TWG meetings and other related activities

 - a. Inclusion in the ILHZ Work and Financial Plan
 - Management/Utilization of the ILHZ Office space & Equipment is covered by a policy/MOP
 - Both are adopted for implementation by the ILHZ through a Board Resolution

- ILHZs in the province of Benguet identified the need to have an ILHZ Manager/District Health Manager who will oversee the general conduct of operations and management of the ILHZ.

Selection/Designation Process

- a. Chief of Core Referral Hospital was unanimously chosen and designated by the ILHZ board through an ILHZ board resolution

- Nomination and subsequent voting by the TWG members
 - •BLIISTT ILHZ

BOARD RESOLUTION No. 2008-03

A RESOLUTION FORMALLY ADOPTING THE INTER-LOCAL HEALTH ZONE (ILHZ) OFFICE AT THE DENNIS MOLINTAS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, DACLAN, BOKOD BENGUET.

WHEREAS, the <u>TWG presented to the body the need</u> to establish an ILHZ office to strengthen the identity of the ILHZ;

WHEREAS, the ILHZ received office equipments under the foreign assisted technical assistance project "Strengthening of the Local Health Systems in the Province of Benguet";

WHEREAS, the office equipments for the ILHZ should be <u>preferably kept</u> in an ILHZ Office;

WHEREAS, the ILHZ conduct regular meetings and other related activities, and the ILHZ office could be a suitable venue;

WHEREAS, a <u>space identified at the Dennis Molintas Memorial</u> Hospital (Water Analysis Laboratory basement) was developed by the TWG to serve as ILHZ office;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, be it resolved to formally adopt the Interlocal Health Zone Office at the Dennis Molintas Memorial Hospital.

- Board Resolution 2007-06: formalize utilization of the space in Benguet General Hospital by the BLIISTT ILHZ




