Observation Programme for Policy Making of Seed Production in Japan

The Observation Programme was successfully conducted in Japan from September 14th to 22nd, 2019. Eight (8) high ranking officials (National Rice Coordinator, National Rice Research Coordinator and DG of 6 concerned State Ministry of Production and Economic Resources) participated in the programme. The objective is to understand the system, the planning and policy making, technique, marketing and commercialization regarding the seed production through the activities of local government to support the high quality seed production in Japan. It is expected to apply what the participants learned in Japan to the real policy making in Sudan. The programme was organized by the Project in collaboration with Ibaraki prefectural government organizations. The visiting schedule and subjects are shown in the table below.


Joint hands towards future

Observation Day at White Nile Research Station

Capacity Building Project for Promotion of Rice Production (JICA) in collaboration with NRP and ARC (White Nile Research Station) conducted Rice Seed Observation Day on 4th November in Kosti. Around 250 people participated in the programme, including VIPs (Governor of White Nile State, Undersecretary of MoA, First secretary of the Embassy of Japan, Chief Representative of JICA Sudan Office, DG of ARC, etc.), senior staff, extensionists, farmers, and media. National TV broadcasted the programme on the same day.

The main objective is to discuss on the further development of rice cultivation and seed production in Sudan through observation of Kosti rice fields. We brought the extensionists and farmers from Gezira State. It was also very good opportunity for them to see other field which was very much succeeded.



Other activities in 2019

Due to the political situation of Sudan, Japanese experts could not come to Sudan from June to September. However Japanese experts contacted to national staff of the Project and counterparts by e-mail or telephone every day, and activities are implemented as have been planned by them.

RS (Registered Seed) were cultivated in ARC HQ (Wad Medani) and FS (Foundation Seed) were cultivated in White Nile Research Center (Kosti). Field inspections were successfully completed twice.





Upland rice cultivation was implemented with 4 locations, 5 farmers at 23 feddans in Gezira State. Because of unexpected heavy and long lasting rains, all farmers were forced to give up rice cultivation this year. Early sowing is necessary to avoid any heavy rain and inundation damage. The ways of drainage should be seriously considered.
