The Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter referred to as "JICA") and National Institute for Emergency Medicine (hereinafter referred to as "NIEM") and the Ministry of Public Health (hereinafter referred to as MOPH) hereby agree that the Record of Discussions (hereinafter referred as the R/D) on Project for Strengthening the ASEAN Regional Capacity on Disaster Health Management (hereinafter referred to as "the Project") signed on 19 February 2016 and the Minutes of Meetings (hereinafter referred as the MM) for the amendment of the R/D singed on 30 August 2017 and the Minutes of Meetings for the amendment of the R/D singed on 6 June 2019, will be amended again as follows:
