

MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES (MAR 2012)

Dien Bien Phu, April 3rd, 2012

I. Purpose

To plan and monitor the monthly activities of Project for Sustainable Forest Management in the Northwest Watershed Area (SUSFORM-NOW) for smooth and effective implementation of the project activities.

III. Contents

3.1 .Implemented activities in Mar 2012

Activity #1 (Annual Plan of Operation (APO) 1-3(1)): Distribute the draft to collect comments and finishing the manual for introducing the project

• The manual was corrected but hasn't distributed for comments.

Activity #2 (APO 1-3(2)): Make schedule and hold the half-day meetings at remaining villages of Ta Leng Site to introduce project

• It hasn't been done yet.

Activity #3 (APO 1-4(1)): Finalize the technical guidelines for formulating the participatory forest management and livelihood development plans

• It was completed.

Activity #5 (APO 1-5(2)): Prepare work plan for improving traditional wine and collecting information on wine making approach of Hmong people living in Keo Lom, invite a Vietnamese consultant from FIRI

- An expert was invited from FIRI and the sample tests on the quality of the local wine were prepared.
- Wine sample has been sent to Food Industries Research Institute (FIRI).

Activity #6 (APO 1-5(2)): Study potential of introducing macadamia plantation

• Potential was studied.

- There were local people's needs.

- Plating macadamia in Vietnam was lack of experiences.
- Quality of macadamia seeds was low.

- Now, Cashew trees (*Anacardium occidentale*) has disease in Vietnam. So, local people are encouraged to plant Macadamia.

Activity #8 (APO 1-5(3)): Hold Improved stove W/S (workshop) at Ta Leng (Phieng Bua & Ke Nenh)

• The workshops were held only at Phieng Bua.

Activity #9 (APO 1-5(3)): Hold W/S for further dissemination of PE-type biogas plants at Ta Leng (Phieng Bua or Na Nghe), invite Dr. Chiem of Can Tho University.

• The workshops were held.

Activity #10 (APO 1-5(3)): Continue monitoring and consultation on raising animals delivered to Phieng Ban, Sai Luong and Tia Ghenh C

• Monitoring and consultation, especially special attention against the blue year disease, were continued.

Activity #11 (APO 1-5(3)): Provide trainings on the organic vegetable at Ta Leng (Phieng Bua & Ke Nenh), and re- training at Hang Tro B

• The trainings were provided.

Activity #12 (APO 1-5(3)): Provide trainings on fodder grass and contour line plantation at Ta Leng, Phieng Ban, and Sai Luong

• The trainings were provided.

Activity #13 (APO 1-5(3): Provide trainings on bamboo shoot, contour line plantation and fruit trees at Ta Leng, Phieng Ban, and Sai Luong

• Trainings on contour line plantation and fruit trees were provided, but not on "bamboo shoot", because 1) the seedling is not ready and 2) the variety of bamboo which people wants to plan need to be confirmed.

Activity #19 (APO 1-5(4)): Prepare for procurement of animals (chicken & fish)

• It was not prepared.

Activity #22 (APO 1-5(5)): Selecting participants who will visit successful livelihood development model in Kon Tum from pilot sites and PMU, and organizing pre-briefing for participants

Study-tour to Kon Tum was conducted.

Activity #23 (APO 1-5(6)): Organize meetings among the city/district, the communes and investor for getting agreement on afforestation (Ta Leng (Ke Nenh, Phieng Bua), Phieng Ban)

• Meetings were organized among local governments, village heads, and investors at Ta Leng Commune, and among local governments, villagers and an investor at Phieng Ban.

Activity #24 (APO 1-5(6)): Facilitate to make agreement between the villagers and investor, and design afforestation (Ta Leng (Ke Nenh, Phieng Bua), and Phieng Ban)

• It's not sure whether the agreements have been made or not, but North-West Viet Forest Joint Stock Company (NORVIFO) started designing in Phieng Ban

Activity #25 (APO 1-5(6)): Make agreement on seedling preparation with villagers and design natural regeneration (Na Phat A)

• It was discussed with the villagers.

Activity #26 (APO 1-5(6)): Issue Livelihoods Development Component (LDC) News No. 16

• LDC News No. 16 was issued.

Activity #28 (APO 1-6(1)): Review the data of the baseline survey by the participants of the training in Japan, at Pilot Sites

• It was reviewed.

Activity #29 (APO 1-6(1)): Continue to monitor endogenous development by Monitoring Volunteer (MV)

• MVs were dispatched until 16/3/2012.

Activity #30 (APO 1-6(1)): Prepare recommendation for improvement of MV system and discussing the renovation ways based on it.

• The recommendation was prepared and Tay Bac University (TBU) was requested to prepare a proposal based on it.

Activity #31 (APO 1-6(1)): Review the reporting form for monitoring Implementation Plan (IP), and guide Villages and Communes to make report appropriately (if necessary, directly monitoring by City/ district PMU (C/DPMU))

• The revised monitoring form was sent to village heads together with filing-sets, and village heads were instructed to fill out the form and submit to Communes/Ward appropriately

Activity #34 (APO 2-2(1)): Prepare training course on animal husbandry for Commune/Ward staff and discuss on it among PMU

• The trainings were conducted.

Activity #41 (APO 2-4(1)): Distribute the table of contents of the technical manual for the 2^{nd} phase to PMU members and discussing on it.

• Draft was distributed as an attachment of the progress report of LDC.

• Vietnamese article was prepared.

• It was requested.
