Local Administration

- 1) Functioning PAPC (Participatory Agriculture Promotion Committee)
- 2) Ensuring budgetary basis for sustaining PAD activities
- 3) Strengthening monitoring & evaluation system at provincial & district levels

By activating PAPC as core unit for implementing/administrating Participatory Agriculture Development (PAD), we expect PAD will be sustained even after Project's end through Lao side's autonomy.

For continuing activities, we will consider how/from where to secure budget.

Marketing / Horticultural Crop Production

Marketing aspect:

1) Strengthening on farmers' groups' management and sales promotion

Horticultural aspect:

- 1) Improving basic cultivation techniques on horticulture crop
- 2) Introduction of seed production

Farmers repaid material cost of greenhouse and those are collected as fund. So, we will motivate farmers to utilize & manage such fund. Also, we are planning activities for match-making farmers' and markets' needs.

As some sites are far from market, it is a disadvantage to transport vegetables. So, we introduce seed production because it is more advantageous.

Dissemination to Other Provinces, etc.

- 1) Revision of Guide Book
- 2) Conducting seminar/workshop for introducing PAD
- 3) Inviting observation team from other provinces

Research Fields by District Staffs

As a part of capacity building on rice cultivation for staffs of District Agriculture & Forestry Office (DAFO), Savan PAD Project is supporting "Research Field" where several DAFO staffs have set their theme of research practically.
