From this volume, we are focusing on District Agriculture & Forestry Office (DAFO) which are striving for technical advice and guidance to farmers at district level.

As of May 2021, Savan PAD Project has been expanding their Target Sites into 12 sites under 9 districts in Savannakhet Province, of which 2 Districts, Xaibouly and Champhone, are the oldest districts related to the project since its beginning.

Although Champhone district is the area where agriculture is thriving next to Xaibouly, there are lots of damages causing from frequent flood. On the other hand, we are trying to strengthen our techniques through young staffs' capacity building and study meeting that provides the occasion for all technical staffs to learn each

other of which they were trained outside. I believe those will help in establishing and further strengthening the earned knowledge and techniques as a section, not only individuals.

Overall

As Target Sites in Champhone are suffering from frequent flood, dry season's cultivation is quite important. Thus, good collaboration with water users' groups is crucial.



Agricultural Techniques (Rice Cultivation)

 Young staff are keen on learning from Japanese experts, provincial staff and proactive farmers. Now they became central to conduct farmers' training, field monitoring and yield survey.

Irrigation / Water User Group Strengthening

- WUG's meetings are held regularly so that skills of water management at 2 Target Sites are being improved.
- As DAFO & WUGs are concerning an effective water distribution, they put effort into utilization of private sector's fund for canal rehabilitation.
- Conducted Seed & Fertilizer Lending Program 5 times. 134 households out of 185 (74%) in the Target Sites have learned techniques of rice cultivation through this program.
- Except the year of severe flood damage, almost 100% of the lent amount was collected from farmers smoothly.
- Yield in 2 Target Sites increased 15%. (Based on dry season's yield survey)
