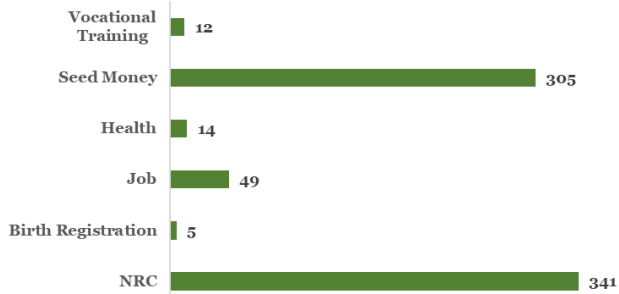

Networking for Victim Centered Support

- ICTP has a strong network of relevant organizations and service providers. By making telephone calls or writing recommendation letters, it provides appropriate referrals to the following organizations.
- Vocational training: vocational training schools of Department of Social Welfare, Myanmar garment manufacturer association and NGOs.
- National Registration Cards and Birth Registration for babies of female survivors: relevant township General Administration Department and Department of Immigration.
- Health care: medical institutions under Ministry of Health and Sports or charity clinics run by volunteers or NGOs
- Job placement: relevant township Department of Labor, Myanmar Women Entrepreneurs Association, private companies and NGOs such as Eden.
- Seed Money for livelihood: DOR, ATIPD, INGOs and CBOs depending on eligibility criteria of each organization.

Achievements of Information Center for Trafficked Persons (2014-2019)

Purpose of ICTP

- ◆ To improve the protection of trafficked persons by providing information and necessary services
- ◆ To refer the trafficked persons to appropriate organizations, service providers and community resources
- ◆ To provide effective rehabilitation services to trafficked persons

Target People

- ◆ Trafficked persons regardless of gender and age including self-returnees
- ◆ Potential victims
- ◆ Family Members / Friends / Neighbors of victims

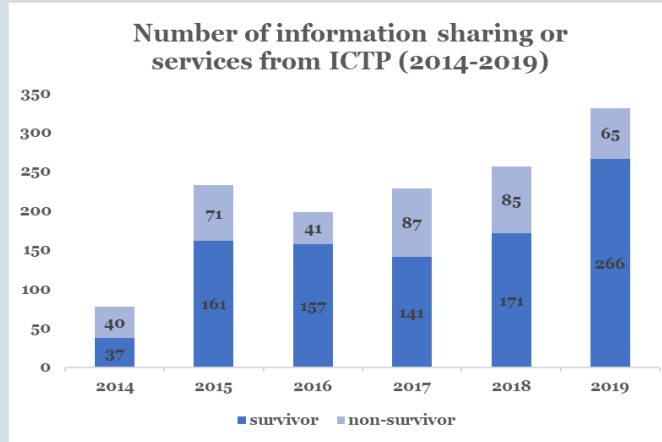


Achievements

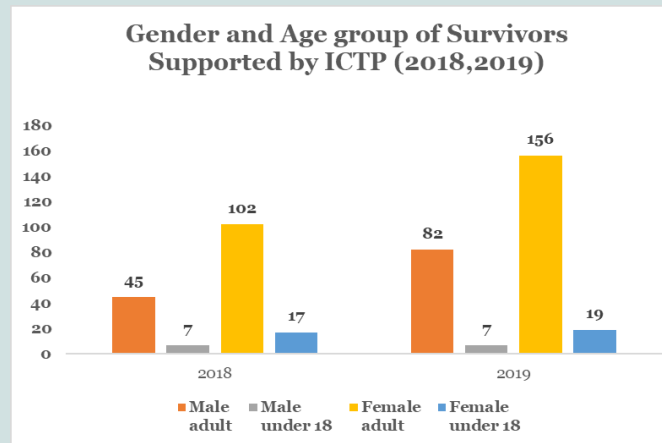


Since its establishment in May 2014, ICTP served more than 1300 clients, including trafficked persons, family members and friends of trafficked or missing persons, and others who seek help.

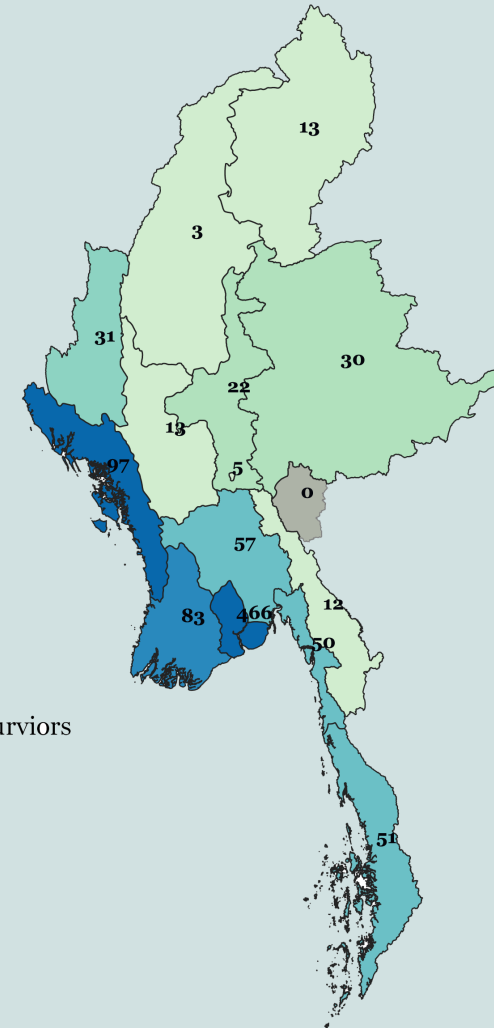
The social workers of ICTP provide necessary information over the telephone or in person. They also support the survivors of trafficking in reintegration and rehabilitation.



- ◆ Male survivors are mostly victims of forced labor in Thailand and Indonesia. Many of them suffered from exploitation on fishing boats.
- ◆ The majority of female survivors experienced forced marriage in China. Some women were rescued from sexual exploitation inside Myanmar.



Geographical Distribution of Survivors Supported by ICTP



- ◆ Survivors who received supports from ICTP are mainly from lower part of Myanmar.
- ◆ Yangon Region showed the highest number of survivors (466 in total)
