







Why Monitor MPAs?

- Measure effectiveness
- Management objectives are met
- Management and Monitoring should go hand in hand



PICRC/JICA Project: 3 yr. Technical Collaboration, which aims to develop:

- $1. \ A \ community-based \ system \ to \ support \ the \\ monitoring \ of \ MPA$
- 2. Partnerships between PICRC and international initiatives, five MC Jurisdictions, related organizations and research institutes



Capacity Building

- 1. States own resources and should do monitoring
- 2. States currently do not have the capacity
- PICRC has the capacity to train conservation officers



Steps taken

- 1. Understand MPA Objectives
- 2. Determine variables both ecological and socioeconomic
- 3. Determine monitoring methods/Analyze capacity
- 4. Select sites
- 5. Train rangers



Variables: • Ecological • Corals/Benthic cover • Fish • Macroinvertebrates (sea cucumbers, sea urchins) • Socioeconomic • Buy-in/Change in attitudes • Stakeholder participation • Stakeholder change in behavior
