Counterpart Training in Japan

The Counterpart Training in Japan was implemented successfully for 4 personnel relevant to the Project for 2 weeks from December 6 to 19, 2009. The main subject of the training was "Sustainable Rural Development through Special Products", and the specific subjects were strawberry and blueberry production, tea harvest mechanization, agricultural marketing, and group activities.
