JICA aims to provide training opportunities and improve quality of vocational trainings conducted through Vocational Training Centers under the supervision of the Ministry of Labour, Public Service and Human Resources Development. Through JICA's assistance, nearly 6,000 youth have been trained in various kinds of skills such as automotive, electrical, building and concrete practice, plumbing and pipe work, carpentry, computer, cooking, tailoring and metal fabrication. The trainings were conducted in Juba, Wau, Malakal and Aluakluak. In Juba, Multi Service Training Center (MTC) renovated by Japan's Grant Aid in 2012 (USD 11.29 Million) was utilized. As an ongoing project, Mr. Isamu Kikuchi, a technical expert for Vocational Training Policy is being deployed to strengthen institutional and administrative capacity of the Directorate of Vocational Training in the Ministry.
